Catechist Formation Process for Catholic School Teachers to Obtain a Full Catechist Certification

- Registration for all Archdiocesan courses and events is through the e-Learning Management System, LMS.
- Preferable to start with Catechist Orientation but all courses can be taken in any order.
- Catechists receive a certificate each time they complete a course, i.e. Vocation certificate, Art of Catechesis certificate and Doctrinal certificate.
- When <u>all three required areas of formation (Vocation, Art of Catechesis and Doctrinal)</u> are completed, the catechist has completed this initial formation process and obtained a full Catechist Certification from the Archdiocese.
- Once initial formation is completed, there are continuing formation opportunities. (e.g. Catechist Convocation and Professional Development workshops.)

Below is an overview of the different opportunities available for catechist formation within each of the 3 formation areas required respective to meeting each catechist where they are in their faith experience/knowledge. *Also acceptable* is completion of the Catechetical Formation Series through Loyola Press, but note, subscription cost would be met by the individual school. (A copy of catechist's completion certificate/letter from Loyola Press for the Catechetical Formation Series is required to be provided to the Catechetical Office within 30 days of completion to update the catechist's LMS account and maintain records).
